team dispute resolution

commercial litigation

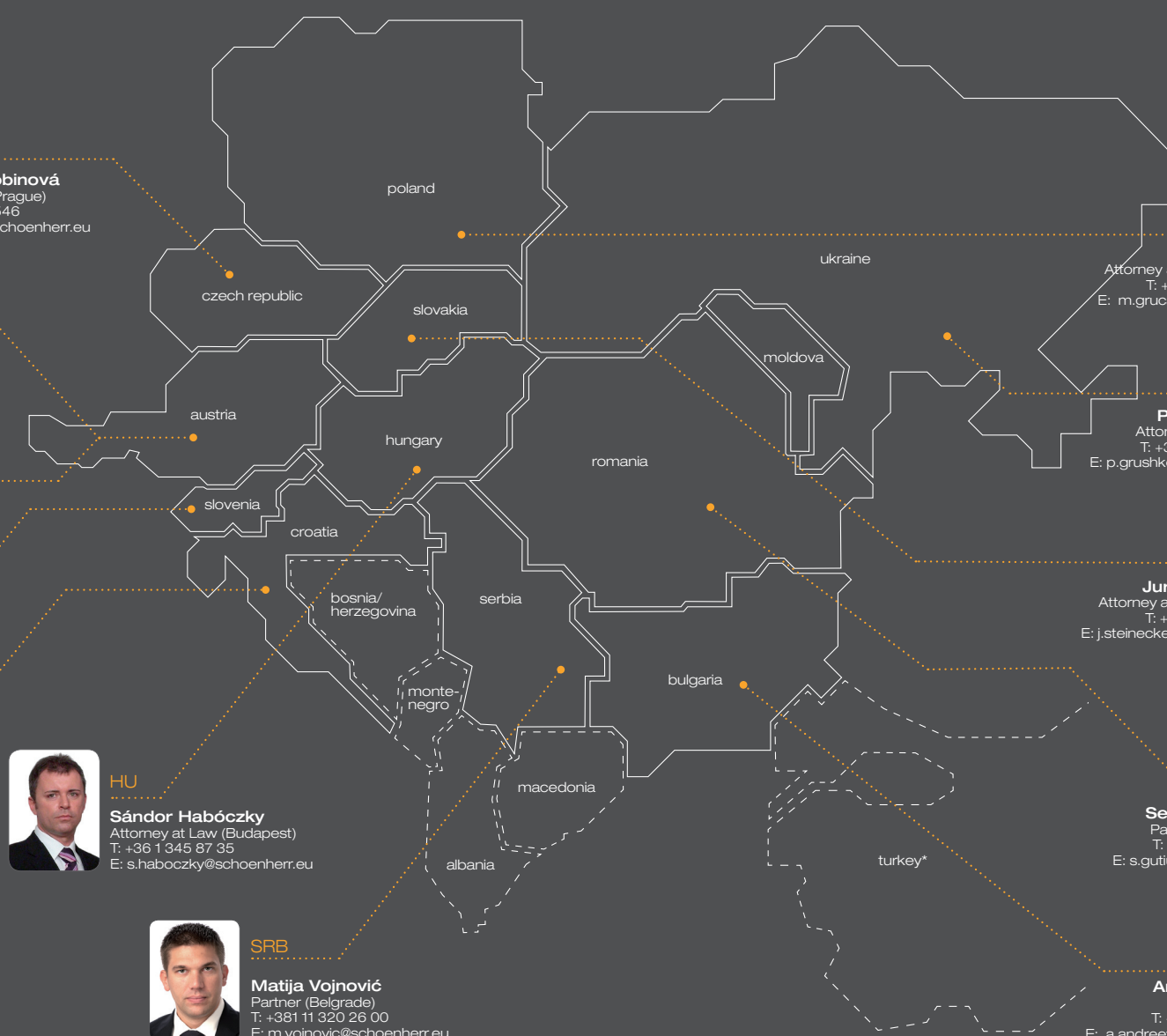
